## **OBJECTIVES:**

- Milford School District's Performance Index Score which is a measurement of our students' performance on the Ohio Achievement/Proficiency Tests will be increased to 102
- The percentage of Milford students whose achievement on the Ohio Achievement/Proficiency Tests placed them in the following categories: Proficient, Accelerated and Advanced will increase each year, and the percent of students in the Basic and Limited categories will decrease
- The Milford School District will attain a 95% graduation rate
- The percent of new teacher retention will improve for those teachers in their first five years of teaching at Milford
- All staff will be provided training for all district initiatives
- Non – mandated educational programs/initiatives will be continued, modified or discontinued based on the results of a benefit/cost analysis
- Increase the number of students participating in gifted, honors, AP courses and dual credit programs
- Install enhanced technology in every building and increase the impact of technology on student achievement
- Increase the awareness and participation of our Milford/Miami township community in our schools
- Conduct an annual community survey each fall regarding district operations and objectives
