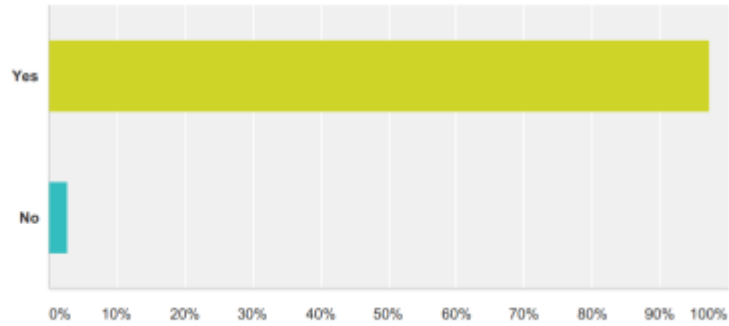

**Q1 Are you a resident of the Milford School District and a registered voter?**

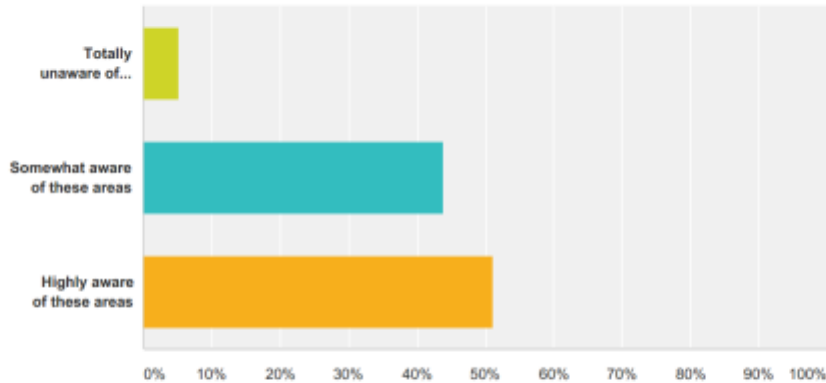

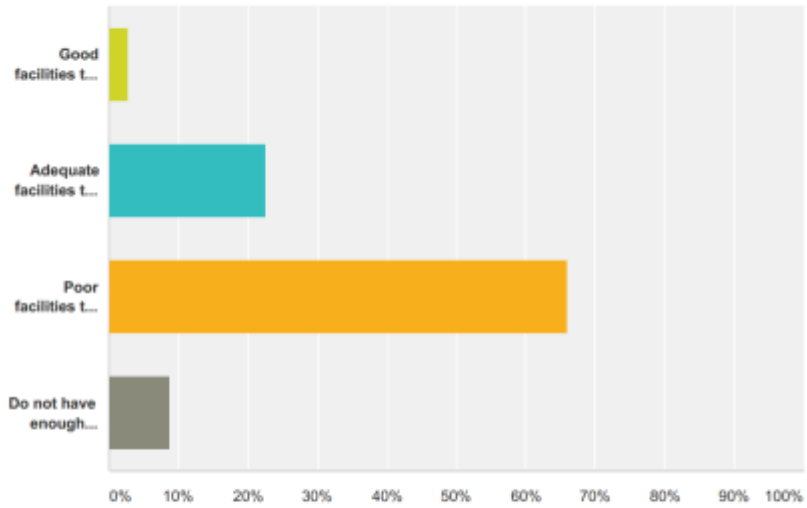

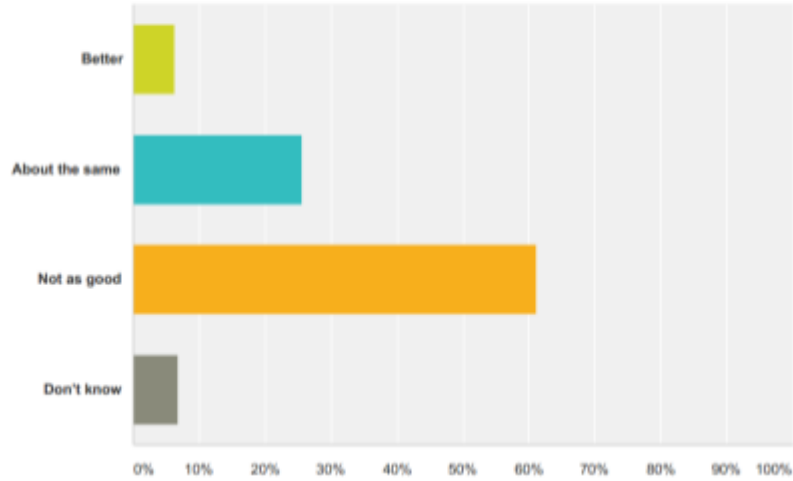

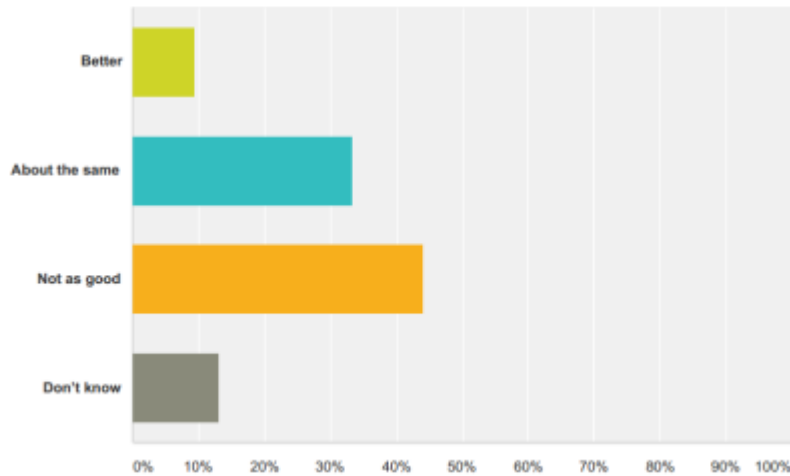

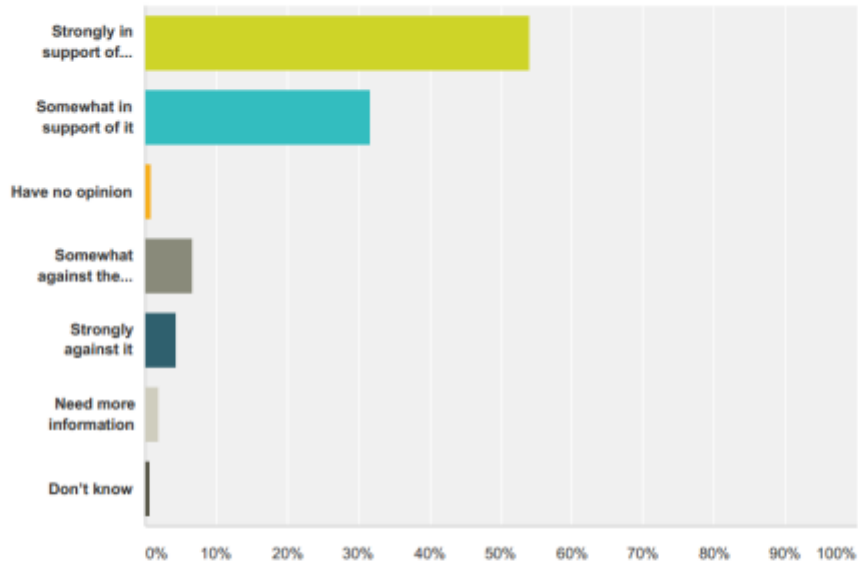

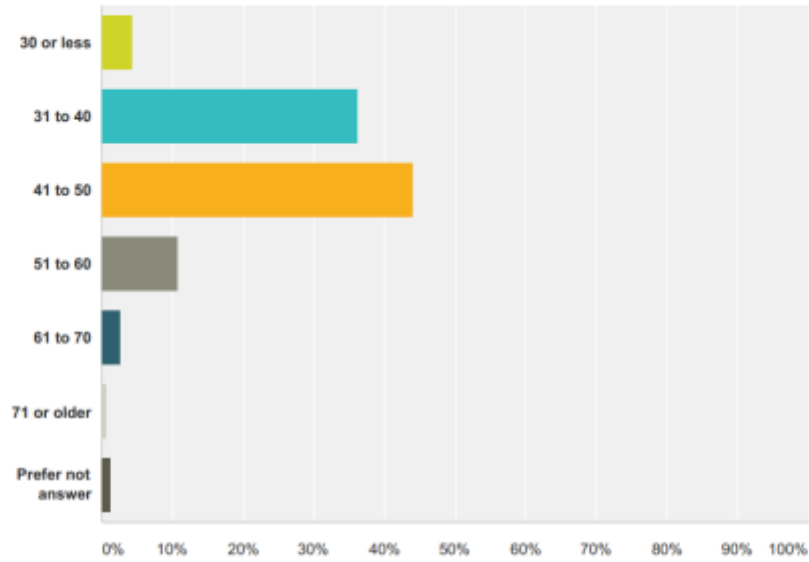

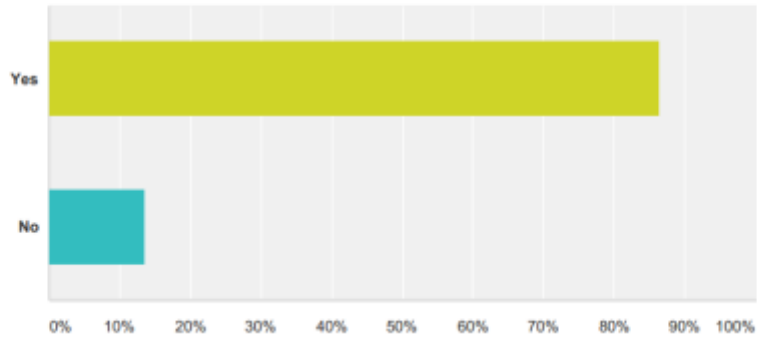

**Q21 Do you currently have children in any of the Milford Schools?**

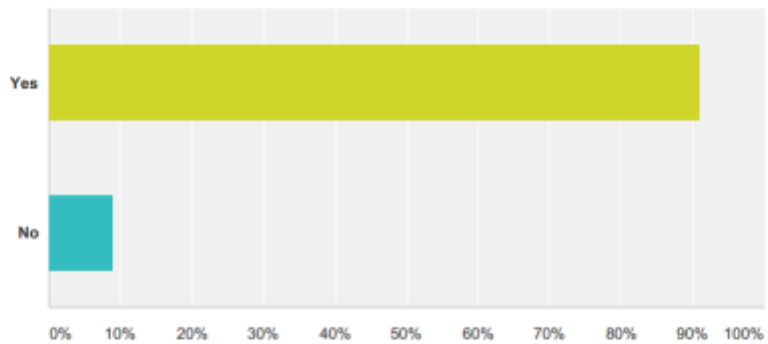

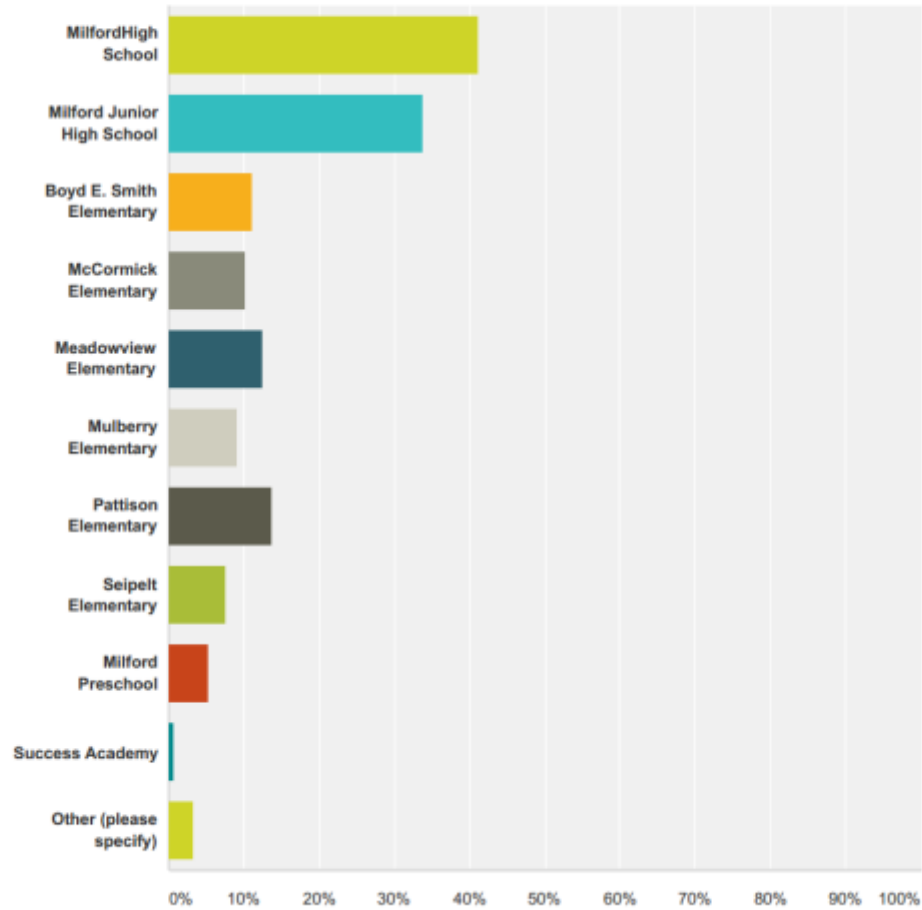

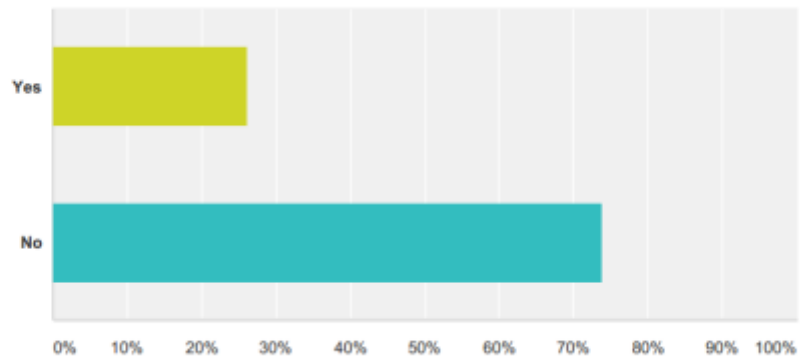
**Q23 If you have children currently attending a school or schools in the district, which school(s) do they attend? (Please mark all that apply).**

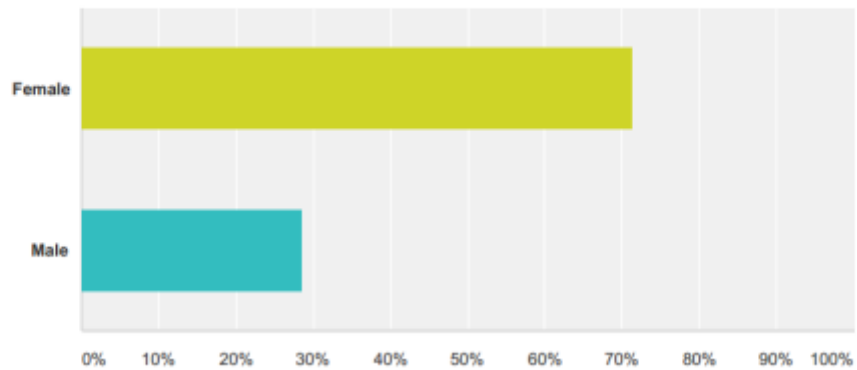
**Q24 Do you currently have, or have you ever, had any children who attend a private or parochial school?**
