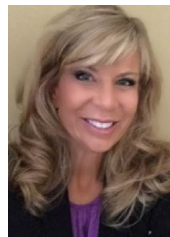
- Financial reports for the month ending June 30, 2018.

Superintendent's Report

Mrs. House shared that the district office staff moved into its new location at 1099 State Route 131. The overall square footage of the building is less than the former building but the open space design will allow for greater efficiency and collaboration among departments. She added that the close proximity to the high school and junior high school is also a great convenience.



Mrs. House thanked Director of Business and Operations Jeff Johnson, Dan Wills, and the entire maintenance and custodial staff for making the move as painless as possible. A grand opening and community open house will be held in the fall.

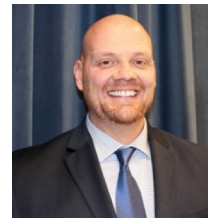
Mrs. House also shared a report on the Portrait of a Graduate work. This strategic planning process will define Milford Schools' vision for the optimally prepared graduate by identifying a prioritized set of competencies that will best prepare students for success now and in the future. The Portrait of a Graduate Design Team includes student, parent/family, educator, business, and other community perspectives. The design team has met four times between March and June and will continue into the fall. The Portrait of a Graduate will officially launch in the winter/spring of 2019.

Mr. Jeff Johnson

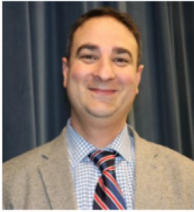
The Board approved participation in the National School Breakfast Program, National School Lunch Program, and National After School Care Snack
