Dear Student:

I hope you are enjoying your summer months! With the opening of a new school year starting on Wednesday, August 18th, we would like to share the enclosed information with you and your parents. Please remember that all students are required to read *Mr. Penumbra's 24 Hour Bookstore* by Robin Sloan for summer reading for their English classes. Additional required readings for Honors and AP English courses can be found at <http://summerreading.milfordschools.org>.

Our Emergency Medical Form can be found on line through Final Forms. It is very important that you complete this form. Without this online registration, we will not have access to your child's medical or contact information in case of any emergency. **Please remember to E-sign.** We are asking that all families have this form completed no later than Wednesday, August 18th (first day of school).

You will be able to pick up class schedules at the high school on **Monday, August 9th from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM or Tuesday, August 10th from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM.** We are asking that all families **pay the course fees at that time.** Course fees may be paid with cash, check, money order or credit card. If you are uncertain of your course fees, go to the district website at www.milfordschools.org and click on Milford High School. The MHS home page includes a link to the website which contains a file with the complete course selection guide where course fees are listed.

We will be taking our underclass school pictures/ID's at the time of class schedule pick up. Please find enclosed the Lifetouch flyer. Please bring your picture order form with you and plan on having your school picture taken when picking up your schedule. *Lifetouch has given you the option to go on line and pay for your pictures at my.lifetouch.com using Picture Day ID EVTM27783. Please go on line and pay for your pictures at my.lifetouch.com using Picture Day IDEVTM27783 or you can also find information on Milford's school web page. Students are asked to follow the school dress code for their school pictures.*

The first day of school, will begin at 7:45 AM and you will report directly to homeroom where you will receive information to share with parents. Your homeroom assignment is listed on your class schedule. *Your locker assignment will be given during your homeroom.* **After homeroom, you will follow a modified bell schedule.** Counselors will review your request for a change of schedule if you meet one of the following conditions: passed the class in summer school; have an incomplete schedule; or failed the class with the same teacher. **The Ohio Department of Education will be offering free breakfast and lunch for students during the 2021-2022 school year. A full lunch menu will be served beginning the first day of school.** The school day will end at 2:30 PM. **The dress code will be strictly enforced beginning with the first day of school, so please dress appropriately.** Students may possess electronic devices, including but not limited to, laptop/tablet computing devices, cellular phones, mp3 players, CD and/or cassette players, cameras, etc. **We ask that all electronic devices be identified with name tags placed on the top of the device as well as the power source. Students may use electronic devices before school, during lunch and after school.** In the classroom, students may use cell phones or other electronic devices **at the teacher's discretion.** Students using an electronic device without permission will be considered to be insubordinate, and will be dealt with as such. The school assumes no liability if these devices are broken, lost, or stolen.

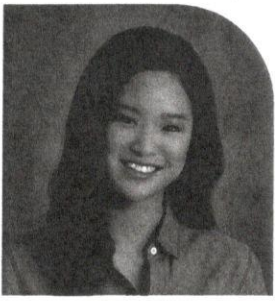
Bus transportation is provided to students. The transportation department will mail specific information to you. The bus driver will designate a safety zone at each stop. At school, buses will park on Eagles Way between the junior and senior high schools. Before school, drivers will release students all at one time and after school, drivers will move their buses after all authorized riders are aboard. For safety reasons, Eagles Way will be closed to traffic between the hours of 7:15 AM to 7:45 AM and from 2:15 PM to 2:45 PM.

All student drop-off and pick-up will occur in the main lot by the flagpole. School personnel will be on school property to assist you.

The parking information and application for students desiring to park on school grounds can be found on our web page. The cost of a parking permit per semester is \$50.00 and the purchase of a parking permit for the entire school year will be \$95.00 (checks made payable to Milford High School). Passes may be purchased throughout the year. School personnel will begin processing parking applications on Monday, August 9th from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM and Tuesday, August 10th from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM at the high school. To secure a parking permit, you need the completed application, a driver's license, proof of insurance and payment. Passes are sold on the basis of availability.

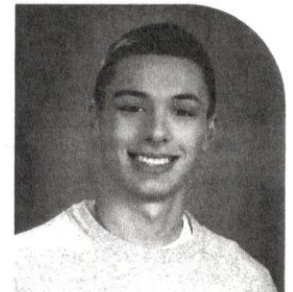
