COVID-19 UPDATE:

- We saw a holiday spike of COVID cases in our district this week, as did the rest of Clermont County.
- Many students have tested positive. Many positive cases were reported to us Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.
- At the HIGH SCHOOL specifically, there are a high number of positive students. Currently (as of 4:00 p.m. Friday) there are 42 positive students at the high school.

- If the high school cases keep coming in like they did this week, then we will take a look at whether or not we will go to a remote learning model AT THE HIGH SCHOOL ONLY. That decision has not been made at this time.
- High School families could get the notification Sunday or Monday if we decide to move the high school to remote learning for two weeks.

- Today we want to express our appreciation to our district's Food Service Staff.

- We are still providing pre-packaged food for families. A total of 8,138 meals are given out weekly.
